The A.K.C. will collect the above fees for each 1<sup>st</sup> Entry of a dog & each Additional Entry of the same dog in regular & non-regular recordable single entry classes in all A.K.C. Licensed & Member Club Events. Event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all fees for the A.K.C. & payment of all fees to the A.K.C. as stipulated in *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2*

The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, and no person shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

There will be no drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. NO DOUBLE HANDLING will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. **There is no provision for unentered dogs at this show.** Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be picked up at the show, none will be mailed. All awards will be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the rightful winner of the award. The Show Secretary should be advised of any award discrepancies.

*ALL ENTRIES IN VETERAN CLASSES WILL RECEIVE A RAINBOW COLORED VETERANS PARTICIPATION RIBBON*

**NOTE:** 1<sup>st</sup> Place winners of Veteran Dog / Bitch and Sled Dog / Bitch Classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed **IF** undefeated in any other class at this show

**NOTE:** Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males **may be entered** in the Veteran Dog Class(s) and spayed females **may be entered** in the Veteran Bitch Class(s) at independent specialties only.

**SLED DOGS & SLED BITCHES ..... RULES:**

1. Entry must be an American Kennel Club or Canadian Kennel Club registered Siberian Husky (eligible under Chapter 15, Section 1, *AKC Rules Applying to Registration & Dog Shows*).
2. There will be a class for dogs and a class for bitches. At the direction of the Show Chair additional classes may be offered based on the requirements of the Sled Dog Degree Program.
3. **If entered in a class for which a full entry fee was paid, no additional fee will be required to also exhibit in the Sled Dog / Bitch classes. If not, the entry fee to exhibit solely in Sled Dog / Bitch will be a regular entry fee of \$25.00.**
4. To qualify for entry in the Sled Dog / Bitch Classes the dog must have completed one of the following three requirements:
  - a. During the previous racing season, each entry must complete twelve (12) heats with a minimum of four (4) miles per heat, or forty-eight (48) miles per season. All races must be on snow with sleds and under the direction of a Recognized Race Giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A Race Season is from April 1 to March 31.
  - b. Entries who complete five (5) years in competition where the above rules are met shall be automatically qualified for the Sled Dog / Bitch Classes. A certificate of proof may be issued by the Chair of the Working Committee if the 5 years of proof of competition records are sent in.
  - c. Entries who have been awarded an SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either SD, SDX, or SDO, and are additionally eligible for entry in a conformation class at an AKC event, are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog / Bitch Classes.
5. **Spayed bitches or neutered dogs are not exhibited in the Sled Dog / Bitch Classes** as required by the American Kennel Club.

A list of races in which the dog competed, or a copy of the five year certificate or a copy of the Sled Dog Degree must be sent to the Show Secretary when entry is made. Proof of qualification must be available at ringside with one of these shown if challenged.

**AWARDS OF MERIT**

In addition to selecting Best of Breed & Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, the judge will select Award of Merit winners. The number selected will be equal to ONE AWARD OF MERIT FOR EVERY 10 DOGS PRESENT IN THE BREED RING. There is no requirement for distribution of these awards between sexes and will be awarded in no particular order.

**BEST IN BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES**

**BEST IN SLED CLASSES**

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES ..... Multiple Dog Entries**

**STUD DOG CLASS** ..... for stud dogs and two of their get  
Owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. The stud dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular Classes, or if it is a Champion of Record, in the Best of Breed Competition. The stud dog shall be considered one entry and requires only one entry fee, this being the Regular Fee **PLUS** the Additional Class Fee, if the stud dog is entered in another class. The stud dog must be shown in the ring with their get. **THE GET MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS IN THIS SHOW.** Judging to be on the merits of the get only.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS** .....same as for the stud dog except substitute brood bitch for stud dog and produce for get.

**NOTE:** Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males **may be entered** as Stud Dog and spayed females **may be entered** as Brood Bitch.

**BRACE CLASS** ..... **Fee is \$20.00 as a unit**  
Effective 1/1/05 – **Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers.**  
**Both dogs in the Brace must have at least one common owner.**

Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry. Please add the name of the other dog in the Brace to your Entry Form.

If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is **NOT ENTERED** in another class at this show, it must be entered for **“BRACE CLASS ONLY”**, with the appropriate individual **Entry Fee of \$25.00. There is no additional fee for a dog entered in another class.**

In making entries for “Brace Class Only”, full particulars must be given on an Official AKC Entry Form. If the dog is entered in another class, Brace must be marked as an “Additional Class”. If more than one Brace is entered by an individual owner, please designate dogs comprising each Brace as “Brace # 1”, “Brace # 2”, etc.

**TEAM CLASS** ..... **Fee is \$20.00 as a unit**  
Effective 1/1/05 – **Four dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers.**  
**All dogs in the Team must have at least one common owner.**

Dogs comprising a Team must be named at the time of entry. Please add the name of the other dogs in the Team to your Entry Form.

If a dog which is to be part of a Team is **NOT ENTERED** in another class at this show, it must be entered for **“TEAM CLASS ONLY”**, with the appropriate individual **Entry Fee of \$25.00. There is no additional fee for a dog entered in another class.**

In making entries for “Team Class Only”, full particulars must be given on an Official AKC Entry Form. If the dog is entered in another class, Team must be marked as an “Additional Class”. If more than one Team is entered by an individual owner, please designate dogs comprising each Team as “Team # 1”, “Team # 2”, etc.

**NOTE:** As the judge’s decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace and Team Classes is based upon the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.
