Additionally, rather than crating your dogs next to your grooming table, there will be an area between the grooming area and the show rings that will be provided for crating dogs. Crates must be stacked. No soft-sided crates will be allowed. Maximum crate size allowed is 36-L x 23-W x 26-H
We are uncertain how much electrical "load" the grooming area can accommodate. Please limit your blow dryer use and share with fellow exhibitors to the extent possible.

- Turn **RIGHT** at the 1st cross street onto Henderson Road
- .4 mile -- Turn **RIGHT** onto Riverdale Road
- .3 mile -- Turn **LEFT** onto E 128th Avenue
- 6.1 miles -- Use the **LEFT W LANES TO TURN LEFT** onto Huron Street
- .5 mile -- Turn **RIGHT** onto West 124th Avenue -- **Clinic will be on the right**

DIRECTIONS FROM HOST HOTEL -- TO -- ADAMS COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS SHOW SITE:

- Start out going **NORTH** on Brighton Road toward W Bromley Lane
- .06 miles – Take the **FIRST RIGHT** onto W Bromley Lane
- .03 miles – Take the **FIRST RIGHT** onto US-85 S / US Highway 85. Continue to follow US-85 south
- 3.79 mile – Turn **RIGHT** onto E 124th Avenue
- .63 miles – E 124th Avenue becomes Henderson Road
- .37 miles – **SHOW SITE / 9755 Henderson Road, Brighton CO is on the RIGHT**

DIRECTIONS FROM HOST HOTEL -- TO -- NORTHSIDE ANIMAL EMERGENCY CLINIC:

945 W 124TH AVENUE -- WESTMINSTER CO 80234

Start out going **NORTH** on Brighton Road toward W Bromley Lane

- .06 miles -- Turn **RIGHT** onto W Bromley Lane
- .03 miles -- Take the **1st RIGHT** onto US Highway 85 / US-85 S. Continue to follow US-85 S
- 4.34 miles -- Turn **RIGHT** onto E 120th Avenue -- If you reach E 112th Ave you have gone about 1.1 miles too far
- .41 miles -- Stay **STRAIGHT** to go onto E 120th Parkway
- 2.06 miles -- E 120th Parkway becomes E 120th Ave
- 4.96 miles -- Turn **RIGHT** onto Huron Street -- Huron Street is just past Melody Drive
- .56 miles -- Turn **LEFT** onto W 124th Ave -- If you reach Home Farm Ave you have gone .1 miles too far
- .10 miles -- **NORTHSIDE ANIMAL CLINIC / 945 W 124TH AVE / IS ON THE RIGHT**

ROUTES TO SHOW SITE There are **MANY** ways to get to the Show Site it is probably best to use your **GPS or GoogleMaps / MapQuest** to determine the best way for your path of travel. However, here are a couple of routes:

FROM THE SOUTH: Exit at I-25 to I-76 East -- Left at I-76 / Hwy 85 fork -- North to 124th Ave
Left on 124th to Show Site (on right)

FROM THE NORTH: I-25 South to Hwy 7 -- Exit east on Hwy 7 to Hwy 85 -- South on Hwy 85 to 124th Ave -- Right on 124th to Show Site (on right) **OR**
North or South on Hwy 85 to 124th Ave --
Left or Right on 124th to Show Site (on right)
